Fun runs will be offered throughout the day and will be worked in as time permits. Fee for Fun Runs will be \$5.00 and a ribbon will be given for each fun run.

Fast CAT TESTS ROLL CALL

Roll call is ½ hour before your block and is the time when participants are expected to check-in. Check-in is followed by inspection for fitness, lameness or “in season” females

TEST HOURS: 8:00 am EST until completed. Blocks will start at 9:00 each day. We will have a lunch break at 12:00 – 1:00

Early acceptance of dogs for members of the event committee may begin one-half hour prior to published test hours.

We will be running the dogs concurrently in blocks, so you will be able to get both runs in the same block. We can adjust the run time for second runs to allow for cooling down dogs.

You will be expected to have complete info for your dog.
Incomplete entries WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

Battery powered; continuous loop equipment will be used. Lures consist of white plastic bags. Electronic timing system will be used with manual timing as a backup. The run out will be a minimum of 50 yards and will be up to 60 yards. The track will be fenced with temporary fencing. Field is short grass and is flat.

EVENT DAY PROCEDURES

Each dog will be inspected by the inspection Committee for Lameness, fitness to compete, and females in season. All dogs to be inspected must be presented without tape, bandages, or wrapping/coverings of any kind (coats, blankets, etc.). If, in the opinion of the inspection committee a dog is found to be lame, unfit to compete, or in season, the dog will not be allowed to test, and the applicable entry fees will be refunded.

Dogs will be brought to the start line on leash and released only upon a verbal signal (“Tally-HO!”) from the Huntmaster. Dogs may be released by hand, folded leash, or using a traditional lure coursing slip lead.

Dogs may run with or without a collar for safety reasons. Unacceptable collars are choker collar, prong collar, or electronic collar. Owners may use clips or rubber bands to hold the dog’s hair. The owner assumes responsibility for the safety of the dog regarding the dog’s collar and paraphernalia on the dog. The event committee at its discretion may require tags hanging from the collar to be secured to ensure the dog’s safety. Electronic training collars or pinch/prong collars are NOT allowed on AKC test grounds.

Ribbons

Club will be providing Rosettes for new titles. Please let us know on entry if you will be getting a title. Qualified ribbons will be given with time, MPH and points on the back. We will also have a rosette for the fastest dog in the three different size groups: Below 12”, 12” to 18”, and 18” or greater.

FAST CAT

The FAST CAT is a timed straight race of 100 yards where a dog chases a lure. Dogs run singularly and earn points based on their handicapped speed. There are no placements. Titles are issued at designated benchmarks. The dog’s time to complete the 100 yard dash is converted into MPH. Dogs earn points based on their handicapped speed. A handicap system is applied to a dog’s MPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- 18” or greater = handicap is 1.0
- 12” up to less than 18” = handicap is 1.5
- Below 12” = handicap is 2.0

Points = MPH multiplied by the dog’s handicap
MPH = 204.545/time

TITLES

Titles are earned by accumulating points. The following titles will be awarded:

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 points

FCAT = 1,000 points

FCAT# = every additional 500 points.

ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNERS SOLE RISK

- All entries must be 12 months old or older on the day of the test.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form
- Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the “Agreement” found on the Official AKC Entry Form
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entries will be refunded
- Mixed breeds must be spayed or neutered to be eligible to run. AKC registered dogs with breed disqualifications may be entered.
- **Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog’s physical strength.**
- **Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog’s entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded**
- **A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field that is not competing in the course in progress**
- Battery powered; continuous loop equipment will be used. Lures consist of white plastic bags.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian’s recommendation to assure their dogs are free of parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.
- Bring your own shade and water
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.
- The event-hosting club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc, assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.

TIPS FOR HANDLERS

1. It is strongly recommended that prior to running your dog, you have a good “recall” control over your dog, as the dogs will be off leash.
2. Handlers should wear comfortable shoes and be physically able to hold and release their dogs, as well as catch them.
3. Dogs will be brought to the start line on leash and released only upon a verbal signal (“Tally-Ho!”) from the Huntmaster. Dogs may be released by hand, folded leash or using a traditional lure coursing slip lead.
4. The catcher is expected to promptly secure the dog in the catch area and leave the field with the dog on leash.
5. Lure coursing is a physically demanding sport so please make sure your dog is in good shape. If you are not sure, make an appointment with a veterinarian to get an opinion.
6. Handlers are advised to warm up their dogs prior to their run and walk them for about 10 minutes afterwards.
7. Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds of the test by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC. Children must be under control of their parents or guardian(s) at all times.
